## Three Categories of Dogs for New Final Rule Importation Requirements (effective August 1, 2024)

Purpose and Audience: To inform general aviation (GA) operators of dog importation requirements effective August 1, 2024.

## Effective August 1, 2024, ALL dogs (including service dogs) arriving in the United States must:

- appear healthy AND
- be at least 6 months old AND
- be microchipped AND
- be accompanied by a CDC Dog Import Form receipt
  - While this form is required for all dogs, importers of dogs from high-risk countries must complete more questions and upload a photo of their dog. Further requirements apply to dogs from high-risk countries. See below.
