MERCHANDISE

Canine for pets, sports, and work.

REQUIREMENT(S)

1.- When entering Mexico with your pet in a clean carrier, you must go to the Agricultural and Livestock Health Inspection Office (OISA) to contact SENASICA official or support personnel, who will verify:

- Shows no signs of infectious or contagious disease,
- Is free of ectoparasites*
- Has no fresh wounds or wounds that are still healing
- "GBG Inspection Certificate for the Transport (Export) of Pet Dogs from the United States to Mexico," signed by a USDA-accredited veterinarian, issued no more than 5 days prior to entry. This requirement will take effect starting August 3, 2026.

*If ectoparasites are found during the physical inspection, the user must contact a Veterinarian of their choice to apply an effective treatment.

If a tick is detected, SENASICA official or support personnel will take a sample of the ectoparasite(s) for diagnosis at the official laboratory and will verify that all specimens found on the pet are removed, keeping the pet at the Agricultural and Livestock Health Inspection Office (OISA) until it is confirmed that they are not exotic specimens for Mexico or subject to an active control campaign. Otherwise, SENASICA, through the General Directorate of Animal Health, will determine the measures to be applied. Any resulting costs will be borne by the importer.

Additional requirements to be met at the Agricultural and Livestock Health Inspection Office (OISA) when the shipment is presented:

- 2.- Meeting the provisions of this document does not relieve the importer from submitting documents or completing any paperwork and/or procedures required by other authorities.
- 3.- If the carrier/crate is presented dirty and/or with disposable bedding (diaper, newspaper, sawdust, rags), toys, or food items, it will be disinfected and everything inside will be removed for proper disposal.
- 4.- Only the portion of balanced pet food intended for the day of arrival is allowed to enter.
